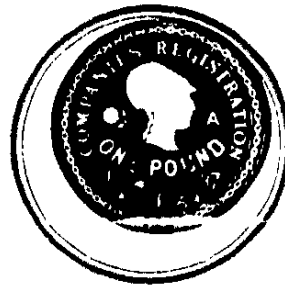

The Deed, if any, containing the charge must be delivered with these particulars to the Registrar within 21 days after the execution of such Deed; or, if there is no such Deed, one of the Debentures must be so delivered within 21 days after the execution of any Debentures of the series.

If any Company makes default in sending to the Registrar for registration the particulars of any charge created by the Company, or of the issues of Debentures of a series, requiring registration as aforesaid, then, unless the registration has been effected on the application of some other person, the Company and every Director, Manager, Secretary or other person, who is knowingly a party to the default, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £50 for every day during which the default continues. (Sec. 80 (5) of the Act.)
