- (4) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (5) the Registrar of Companies to advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

AND THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that, on the Claimant's application, the costs of and incidental to this application shall be reserved for determination in any claim brought by Neil Lang against Archibald Brown & Co Limited in the event that his claim for damages against the said Archibald Brown & Co Limited is successful
