AT an EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING of the Members of the said Company, duly convened and held at the Offices of the Company, 4A, Cockspur Street, London, S.W., on the Eleventh day of September, 1899, the following Special Resolutions were duly passed; and at an EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING of the Members of the said Company, also duly convened and held at the same place on the Twenty-seventh day of September, 1899, the said Special Resolutions were duly confirmed.


RESOLUTIONS.

1. That, subject to the approval of the Board of Trade, the name of the Company be changed from the name "THE RITZ HOTEL SYNDICATE, LIMITED" to the name "THE RITZ HOTEL, LIMITED."
2. That the Capital of the Company be increased from £120,000 to £160,000, by the creation of 6,000 Ordinary Shares of £5 each, and that such new Ordinary Shares confer on their respective holders the same rights in all respects as the existing Ordinary Shares, so that the profits of the Company in each year shall be applicable in the first instance to the payment of a non-cumulative dividend at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum on the Capital paid up on the Ordinary Shares, including the new Ordinary Shares, and in the next place, as to two-thirds of the surplus in payment of a further dividend on such paid-up Capital, and as to the one other one-third of such surplus in payment of a dividend on the Deferred Shares of the Company.
3. That Article 54 of the Articles of Association be amended by the addition of the following words, viz.: "or such larger sum, whether annual or otherwise, as may from time to time be determined by the Company at any General Meeting."
4. That Article 66 of the Articles of Association shall be modified to the extent that the "Ordinary Shares" therein mentioned shall be deemed to include the said new Shares.
5. That Article 84 of the Articles of Association of the Company shall not apply to the new Capital now to be created, but such new Capital, as well as any existing Capital which has not yet been issued, shall be issued and disposed of at such time, in such manner, to such person or Corporation, and on such terms as the Directors shall think fit.
6. That throughout the Articles of Association the words "the Syndicate" be read and construed as if they were the words "the Company."


