### THE BURY FOOTBALL CLUB COMPANY LIMITED (the "Club") (company voluntary arrangement)

In accordance with Rule 1.26 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 I am pleased to provide my second report on the voluntary arrangement and enclose as Appendix I an account of my receipts and payments to 31 May 2004. I comment further on the progress of the Arrangement below.

### 1 Receipts and payments

- 1.1 I am currently holding the sum of £12,904.16 in respect of the voluntary contributions to date. This is made up of the balance from the administration and voluntary contributions over the last two years, net of payments to creditors and expenses over the last 2 years.
- 1.2 I can confirm that the Club has complied with the terms of the arrangement to date.
- 1.3 The Club is currently 2 months in arrears with its voluntary contributions. The Supervisors were made aware of this prior to the arrears accruing and have been assured by the Club, in writing on 3 February 2004, that the arrears will be brought up to date with future contributions.
- 1.4 These arrears are within the terms of the voluntary arrangement and it is neither required nor proposed to take any further action unless further arrears accrue.

#### 2 Creditors claims

2.1 The claims of the preferential creditors have now been received and are detailed below:

- 2.2 On 28 April 2004, a first distribution of 20p in the £ was made to preferential creditors totalling £56,494.27.
- 2.3 The preferential claim of the Inland Revenue has increased since my last report by £962.03 due to an omission of outstanding PAYE/NIC in respect of the Social Club.
- 2.4 This amount was being pursued by the Inland Revenue through the Bolton County Court and they have now withdrawn that action and formally claimed in the voluntary arrangement.
- 2.5 The claims of non-preferential creditors are still being received along with details of their distribution requirement for the cash dividend or issue of shares.
- 2.6 Currently, only two creditors have formally requested the issue of shares as opposed to a cash distribution.
- 2.7 All creditors who have not yet submitted their formal claim should do so as soon as possible. A further claim form is attached.
- 2.8 Also, creditors should, when submitting their claim form, confirm as to how they wish to receive their distribution. A separate form is attached for this purpose.
- 2.9 Please note that all distributions to non-preferential creditors, whether in cash or shares, will take place as and when the voluntary arrangement is successfully completed.

#### 3 Other matters

- 3.1 Under the terms of the arrangement, I have a duty to review the formal accounts of the Club every 12 months.
- 3.2 I have now reviewed the accounts for the year ended 31 May 2003. Under the terms of the arrangements, no additional contribution is required from the Club as no profit was made in the period.
- 3.3 Upon receipt of the audited accounts for the year ended 31 May 2004, I will be able to review any profits made and request any contribution due from those profits, if applicable.
- 3.4 Preferential claims are presently higher than initially indicated by the Club's records. The breakdown of these has only recently been received. I am investigating the increase and working to address ways of dealing with it.
- 3.5 Should amendments to the proposals be appropriate or necessary, I will write to you under separate cover.
- 3.6 My next report will be provided shortly after the third anniversary of the voluntary arrangement when I should be able to confirm the final level of non-preferential claims.
