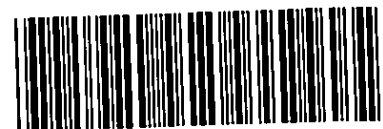
UPON THE APPLICATION of Thomas Lawrence Greener suing by his Wife and
