ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

PROPOSAL BY COUNCIL

ARTICLE 8(d)

PRESENT ARTICLE

the Representatives of The Universities-Athletie-Union, the Independent Schools' Football Association, The English Schools' Football Association and the Football Associations of Australia, Canada and New Zealand shall each be entitled to one (1) share;

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Delete "The Universities Athletic Union" in lines 1 and 2 and delete ", Canada" in line 6.

PROPOSED BY MR W R GOSS (AMATEUR FOOTBALL ALLIANCE FA) SECONDED BY MR F D PATTISON (DURHAM COUNTY FA)

ARTICLE 36(a)(1)(ii)

PRESENT ARTICLE

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

There shall be a Council and it shall consist of:-

- (1) the following elected Officers
 of The Association:;
 namely:-
 - (i) the President;
- (ii) not more than six (6) elected Vice-Presidents./

After the word "Vice-Presidents" in (ii), delete the full stop and insert:-

"and any additional Vice-Presidents appointed by Council under the provisions of Article 41(c) of these Articles"

PROPOSED BY MR W R GOSS (AMATEUR FOOTBALL ALLIANCE FA) SECONDED BY MR F D PATTISON (DURHAM COUNTY FA)

ARTICLE 36(c)

PRESENT ARTICLE

Upon any Member of Council becoming a Life-Member or a Life Vice-President the Member shall automatically cease to be an elected Member of the Council and thence forth shall not be eligible for election as an Officer of The Association of for election or appointment as an elected Member of the Council, but an ex-officio Officer of The Association shall not cease to be an ex-officio Officer of The Association nor shall the Member cease to be a member of the Council by reason of becoming a Life Member or a Life Vice-President./

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

After the word "Vice-President" in line 15 insert:-

"Upon any Member of Council becoming a Life Member or a Life Vice-President, the body represented on Council by the said Member shall be entitled to appoint a new Representative."

PROPOSAL BY MR W R GOSS (AMATEUR FOOTBALL ALLIANCE FA) SECONDED BY MR F D PATTISON (DURHAM COUNTY FA)

ARTICLE 36(d)

PRESENT ARTICLE

;

Upon-any-Member-of-Council-becoming-a Life-Member-or-a-Vice-President;-the body-represented-on-Council-shall-be entitled-to-appoint-a-new Representative;

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Delete current Article, which has been incorporated in 36(c) and replace with:-

"Upon any Member of Council becoming a Vice-President or an ex-officio Vice-President the body represented on Council by the said Member shall, during the tenure of the said Member's office as a Vice-President or an ex-officio Vice-President, be entitled to appoint a new Representative."

PROPOSAL BY COUNCIL

ARTICLE 37

PRESENT ARTICLE

No person shall be eligible for election as a Vice-President unless serving as a Member of the Council. Representatives of the Associations of Australia, Canada and New Zealand shall not be eligible for election as a Vice-President or appointment as a Life Vice-President or a Life Member.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

In line 5 delete ", Canada".

PROPOSAL BY COUNCIL

ARTICLE 38

PRESENT ARTICLE

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Council shall have power annually to elect to the Council a representative of:-

(i) The Universities Athletic Union;

Delete Clause (i)

(ii) the Independent Schools' Football Association;

Re-number remaining clauses (ii) and (iii) as (i) and (iii).

(iii) each of the following Associations:-

Australia; Canada; - New Zealand.

Delete reference to "Canada" in Clause (iii).

REASON

The Universities Athletic Union has ceased to exist.

The Canadian Football Association decided that it was no longer appropriate for them to be represented on the FA Council.
