### CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT

The Directors have pleasure in submitting their Seventy-Fourth Annual Report to the Members, together with the audited Accounts for the year ended 31st May 1984.

The year was eventful, if not as successful as we might have hoped. However, a very positive end to the Seasor resulted in the Club finishing 6th in the League Championship. One of the highlights of the Season was the performance of the Reserve Team, who son the Football Combination League. The Youth Team also had a successful Season, winning the Southern Junior Floodlit Cup, and reaching the semi-finals of the FA Youth Cup and the South East Counties League Cup. The performance of all the young Players in the Club gives us hope that the future is being planned on a firm footing.

After adjustment for taxation and extraordinary profit on property transactions, we report a loss for the year under review of £743,789. Although attendances for League games advanced by 16%, revenue from Cup Ties was down and transfer fees paid exceeded receipts by £1,262,500.

During the year, we acquired the services of Charlie Nicholas, Tommy Caton, Paul Mariner and John Lukic and we are confident that they will make a big contribution to the 1st Team again in the coming Season. Viv Anderson was signed in the summer and we feel that we now have a very firm base from which to launch the coming Seasons campaign.

In December 1983, we terminated Mr Terry Neill's Contract as Manager. Mr Neill made a significant contribution to the Club during his eight years as Manager and I would like to place on record our gratitude.

Mr Don Howe was confirmed as Manager towards the end of the Season and we hope that the Club will continue to prosper under his stewards to. We are proud that he will also continue as Coach of the England Team.

We were delighted to invite Mr David Dein to join the Board in September 1983. He has already made a significant contribution to the affairs of the Club and the Board were equally pleased that Mr Dein accepted their invitation to become Vice-Chairman in January 1984. His enthusiasm and energy, I am sure, will prove to be of great value to the Club in the years ahead.

We have a particularly dedicated staff at Highbury and I would like to thank them all once again for their hard work and continued loyalty.
