- 1 'Director' includes any person who occupies the position of a director, by whatever partie called, and any person in accordance with whose directions or instructions the directors of the company are accustomed to
- 2 For an individual, his prosent christian name(s) and surname must be given, together with any previous Christian name(s) or surname(s).

"Christian name" includes a forecame. In the case of a paer or person usually known by a title different from his surname, "surname" means that title, in the case of a corporation, its corporate name must be given.

A previous christian name or sumame need not be given it.

- (e) a dormant company (which is a company which has had no transactions required to be entered in the company's accounting records, except any which may have arisen from the taking of shares in the company by a subscriber to the memorandum as such).
- (b) a body corporate of which the company making the return was a wholly-owned subsidiary;
- (c) a wholly-owned subsidiary of the company making the return; or
- id) a wholly-owned subsidiary of a body corporate of which the company making the return was also a wholly owned subsidiary.
