During 2021 the Trustee Board saw some changes, sadly Mr Howard Glass passed away. Mrs Ann Blackburn retired due to ill health and Mrs Sue Chapman resigned following the loss of her husband and moving closer to family which has taken her out of the area. The three Trustees had been with the charity for many years and offered mcuh support during their time and they will be a great loss to the board. The board are extremely grateful for their work during their time with the Goole Samaritans.

The registered address is primarily the office of Castaway Music Theatre and along with the Goole Samaritans is also shared with the Hook and Goole Charity.

The 105th Annual Général meeting of the Society was postponed due to the Covid 19 pandemic and was held on 9th December 2021 and covered both 2020 and 2021.

In accordance with the Memorandum and Articles of Association, the Chairwoman Mrs Christine Burton stood down and was duly re-lected as Chair.

The Trustees have also appointed Mr K Barclay as vice chair.

The nominates members were then unanimously re-elected to their posts.

Fund Management

2021 was a year of continued uncertainty due to the Covid 19 pandemic. The shares held by the charity did remain stable and saw an increase in value over the year. The shares that had been held at Redmayne Bentley at the previous year end were sold and re-bought by Malloch Melville. Any loss was compensated by Redmayne.

Two part sets of shares that formed part of the Permanent Endowment Fund were sold in 2021 to realise cash for use with other purchases.

1185.31 Infrastructure - £ 1,767.55 (Cost Value) 8738.92 Artemis Fd Mngrs - £ 4,505.58 (Cost Value)

This yielded a small profit of £ 2,328.26.

The following purchases were made during the year :-

5000 Digital 9 - £ 5,095.00 (Cost) 2016 European Assets - £ 2,999.59 (Cost)

These shares form part of the Permanent Endowment Stock

There has been some fluctuations within the stock market this year. The charity's share value has increased during the year despite the global pandemic.

The income from the shares in 2021 saw a decrease on the previous years figures of £ 749.18. This is the second year that the charity has ssen a decrease in the income. It is hoped that 2022 will see a positive change in this as the markets settle.

Income

The income for the society from all sources for the current year 2021 amounted to £ 8,274.46 (2020 £ 9,023.64), this is a decrease on 2020 of £ 749.16. The total income raised from the Society's endowment holdings totals £ 7,828.81 (2020 £ 8,569.34). This year we also received £ 434.77 (£ 445.2) from the shares held in the Accumulated Income Fund. A total of £ 8,263.58 has been received in share income for 2021.

Grants and Allowances

During this financial year the Charity made funds available for grants. The sums available for grants were less than the previous year and restricted for emergency situations. This year a total of 15 grants were issued.

There was a slow start to the year of grant requests. This was mainly due to organisations being in lockdown at the early part of 2021 and the support teams not easily accessign those in need. 2021 saw an increase in grant requests on the previous year. £ 4,800.00 was spent on grant requests. The charity has seen an increase in the cost of items needed by grantees and has increased the amount available for each individual request in light of this. DT will make contact early in 2022 with the external organisations to remind them that Goole Samaritans has the finances available to offer grants for goods for families in need.

The Trustees will continue to review the situation regarding income/funding in 2022 with a view to hopefully being able to continue to offer a similar number of grants in the coming year.

Administration Costs

The administration costs for 2021 were £ 3,000.00, (2020 £ 3,000.00) plus Companies House fees of £ 13.00 (2020 13.00), Indemnity Insurance £ 312.10, (2020 £ 321.40). Bank charges levied were £ nil (2020 £ nil) Office rental £ 325.00 (2020 £ 325.00). Miscellaneous costswere £ nil (2020 £ 33.00). Redmayne Bentley Broker Fees £ 0.00 (2020 £ 195.00)

The Charity continues to be registered under the Data Protection Act 1998 at a cost of £ 35.00 per annum, (2020 £ 35.00).

The auditors costs for 2021 were £ 900.00, (2020 £ 900.00).

1. Accounting Policies

1.1 Accounting Convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value at the balance sheet date. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Companies Act 1985 and the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities 2005.

1.2 Income And Expenditure

Income and expenditure from operations is accounted for on an accrual basis, except for membership subscription which is accounted for when received.

1.3 Investments

Investments are stated at market value at the balance sheet date. The SOFA includes the net gains and losses arising on revaluations and disposals throughout the year.

1.4 Fund Accounting

General funds are unrestricted funds which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity and which have not been designated for other purposes. Endowment funds represent those assets which must be held permantly by the charity. Income arising on the endowment funds can be used in accordance with the objects of the charity and is included as unrestricted income. Any capital gains or losses arising on the investment form part of the fund. Investment management charges relating to the fund are charged against the fund.
