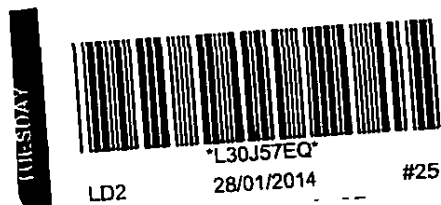

Basis of accounting
