Notes

'Director' includes any person who occupies the position of a director, by whatever name called, and any person in accordance with whose directions or instructions the officers of the company are accustomed to act.

For an individual, his present Christian names(s) and surname must be given together with any previous Christian names(s) or surname(s).

* Christian name* includes a Christian name. In the case of a person usually known by a title different from his surname, "surname" means that title. In the case of a corporation, its corporate name must be given.

A previous Christian name or surname need not be given if:—

(a) in the case of a married woman, it was a name by which she was known before her marriage, or

(b) it was changed or ceased to be used at least 20 years ago, or before the person who previously used it reached the age of 18, or

(c) in the case of a peer or a person usually known by a Christian title different from his surname, it was a name by which he was known before he adopted the title or succeeded to it.

(e) a body corporate of which the company making the return was a wholly-owned subsidiary;

(f) a wholly-owned subsidiary of the company making the return; or

(g) a wholly-owned subsidiary of a body corporate of which the company making the return was also a wholly-owned subsidiary.
