- b) Depreciation has been calculated by the reducing balance method as follows:-

Freehold Land and Buildings at 2% P.A. (Ex Valuation) Floodlight Installations at 10% P.A. Fixtures, Fittings, Plant etc. at 10% P.A.

- c) Stocks are valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value.
- d) Transfer fees receivable and payable are written off as incurred.

- b) No employee was paid more than £30,000 during the year.

The Number 2 Account overdraft is secured by personal guarantees of the directors.

The Bank Loan Account is secured by the personal guarantees of the directors.

The Brewery Loan (Greenall Whitley) is interest free and secured by deeds on 285 square yards known as the Supporters Club and is repayable over a period of 20 years from 1975.

The grant from Wigan Metropolitan Borough Council in respect of the All Weather Play Area is interest free and repayable at 1 year's notice by both parties.
