# STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2005

### Accounting convention:

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with accounting standards applicable in the United Kingdom.

### Amounts owed by group undertakings:

Provision is made should the Directors consider that amounts owed by group undertakings are not fully recoverable.

### 1. DORMANT STATUS

The Company was dormant (within the meaning of Section 249AA of the Companies Act 1985) throughout the financial year ended 31 December 2005. The Company has not traded during the financial year or during the preceding financial year. During the financial year, the Company received no income and incurred no expenditure and therefore made neither profit nor loss. None of the Directors received any emoluments in respect of their services to the Company.
