NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2014

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Land and buildings - 15% on reducing balance, Straight line over 15 years and Not provided on land

Plant and machinery etc - 25% on cost, 25% on reducing balance and 15% on reducing balance

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Grants and contributions

Grants and contributions received in respect of reinstatement of buildings following the acquisition of part of the Nursery by Union Railways (North) Limited have been deducted from the cost of new buildings and other fixed assets. This is not in accordance with Schedule 4 to the Companies' Act 1985, which requires assets to be shown at their purchase price or production costs and hence grants and contributions to be presented as deferred income. This departure from the requirements of the Act is, in the opinion of the directors, necessary to give a true and fair view as the changes were forced upon the company and the aim of the grants and contributions was to reinstate the company to its pre-disturbance position. The effect of this departure is that the net book value of fixed assets is £ 439,684 lower than it would otherwise have been.
