UPON the winding up petition presented on 13 March 2019 (the "Petition") by Douglas MacDonald of the MacDonald Partnership Limited, 29 Craven Street, London WC2N 5NT acting in his capacity as administrator of Mitre Property Management Limited (the "Company")

AND UPON reading:

- (1) the first and second witness statements of Douglas MacDonald dated 8 March 2019;
- (2) the statement of qualification to act as an insolvency practitioner and the consent to act filed by Douglas MacDonald pursuant to rule 7.56(2) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 (the "Rules")

AND UPON the court being satisfied that the EU Regulation on Insolvency Proceedings applies and these are main proceedings

AND UPON hearing James Davies, of counsel, for Douglas MacDonald

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The administration order dated 11 July 2003 in relation to the Company be discharged pursuant to section 18 of the Insolvency Act 1986 (the "Act").
2. The administrator, Douglas MacDonald, shall be released from all liability pursuant to section 20 of the Act with effect from 14 days after

the filing of the final receipts and payments account in accordance with rule 3.59 of the Rules.

3. Service and advertisement of the Petition be dispensed with.
4. The Company shall be wound up by the court under the provisions of the Act.
5. Pursuant to section 140(1) of the Act, Douglas MacDonald shall be appointed as liquidator of the Company.
6. Pursuant to rule 12.39(9) of the Rules, the second witness statement of Douglas McDonald dated 8 March 2019 together with the documents referred to therein and the documents contained within exhibit DCM2, must not be made available for inspection or be copied without the permission of the court.
7. The costs of Douglas MacDonald of and occasioned by this Petition shall be costs in the administration.
