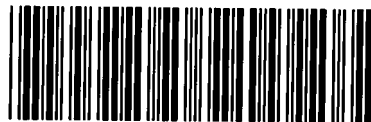

1. Accounting Policies

The Company has elected to adopt the transition option of FRS 102 35.10 (m) which enables the Company to retain its existing accounting policies for reported assets, liabilities and equity at the date of transition to FRS 102 until there is a change to those balances or the company undertakes any new transactions.

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements:

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards and under the historical cost convention.

The company is exempt from the requirement to prepare a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a wholly owned subsidiary of a company incorporated in Great Britain.

Related Party Transactions

Under the Financial Reporting Standard 8 the company is exempt from the disclosure of transactions with other group undertakings on the grounds that it is a wholly owned subsidiary of Aeromet Holdings Limited, and its results are included in the consolidated financial statements of Aeromet Holdings Limited.
