## Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 30th September 2020

#### 1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Wright Bro's Coaches Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

#### 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain assets.

#### Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life or, if held under a finance lease, over the lease term, whichever is the shorter.

Freehold property - 2% on cost

Short leasehold - in accordance with the lease
Plant and machinery - 15% on reducing balance
Motor vehicles - 20% on reducing balance

#### Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

#### Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Statement of Income and Retained Earnings, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

#### Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

### 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

#### Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts or finance leases are capitalised in the balance sheet. Those held under hire purchase contracts are depreciated over their estimated useful lives. Those held under finance leases are depreciated over their estimated useful lives or the lease term, whichever is the shorter.

The interest element of these obligations is charged to profit or loss over the relevant period. The capital element of the future payments is treated as a liability.

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to profit or loss on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

#### Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

#### **Investment properties**

Land and buildings include investment properties. Investment properties are valued in the financial statements at their current market value. No depreciation is provided in respect of freehold investment properties or leasehold investment properties which have more than 20 years of the lease to run.

Within Land and Buildings are investment properties 1 and 2 Hillersdon Terrace, Nenthead, Cumbria. Under FRS102 these properties were revalued as at 29th September 2020 by a further £20,250 above the revaluation increase of £7,450 conducted on 30th September 2018. The market value was carried out by Red Hot Properties of 13 Battle Hill, Hexham.

The valuation increase of £20,250 was credited to the Profit and Loss Account in Other Operating Income in the year. A corresponding charge to the Profit and Loss Account was made in Administrative Expenses for £20,250 to take the revaluation to Other Reserves that are not distributable. The balance on Other Reserves has risen to £147,218 as a result. All other properties within Land and Buildings are stated at cost and have not been revalued.
