By executing the Upstream Loan Agreement, the Company will make available to Foseco plc (No. 5413927) (the "Assisted Company") a revolving loan facility of up to £46,000,000 in order to enable the Assisted Company to make payments when due under a facilities agreement dated 4 May 2005 between, inter alia, the Assisted Company and The Royal Bank of Scotland plc (as amended or restated from time to time), any such advances under the facility to be made only if the aggregate of all monies standing to the credit of all its bank accounts exceeds the amount of the proposed advance.
