Cumulative Preference Shares of £1 each and 104,000,000 Ordinary Shares of 25p each to £26,000,000 divided into 104,000,000 Ordinary Shares of 25p each. At the date of registration of this Minute 87,648,139 of the said Ordinary Shares have been issued and are deemed to be fully paid up and the remainder are unissued."
