INTRODUCTION

Soil Mechanics Limited (Entity) entered members' voluntary liquidation on 28 January 2019. Emma Cray and David Matthew Hammond were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This account covers the conduct and progress of the liquidation in the period from 28 January 2019 to 24 January 2020 (Period). This is the Liquidators' final account of the liquidation.

A summary of receipts and payments in the liquidation is at Appendix A.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

Following their appointment, the Liquidators took control of the assets listed in the directors' Declaration of Solvency. See appendix A for details.

The Liquidators have not identified any additional assets of the Entity and are not aware of any other assets that remain to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency showed that the Entity had no liabilities.

HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"):

Following their appointment, the Liquidators wrote to HMRC to inform them of the liquidation and to request details of any outstanding liabilities. HMRC have confirmed that the Entity has no outstanding tax liabilities and that they have no objection to the liquidation being closed.

Distributions to Members:

On 9 December 2019, an in specie distribution of £1 (representing approximately £1 per share) was made to the Member of the Entity. The distribution consisted of an assignment of an intercompany debtor due from Socotec UK Limited.

The value attributed to the distribution was based on the value at which the asset was held in the Entity's books.

LIQUIDATORS' FEES AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration

The basis of the Liquidators' remuneration has been fixed by reference to the time properly given by them and their staff in dealing with the liquidation, in accordance with a resolution dated 28 January 2019.

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Liquidators' remuneration

As there were no funds in the estate, the Entity's indirect Member, Socotec UK Limited agreed to settle all costs associated with the liquidation of the Entity and 6 other connected entities.

In the Period, the Liquidators have been paid £11,600 plus VAT in respect of the Entity and 6 connected entities.
