

Associated Lighting Group Limited, Ring Group Limited, Ring Lamp Company Limited, Trident Limited – all in Administration (together "the Companies")

I write further to my appointment as Joint Administrator of the above Companies and attach a copy of my statement of proposals in accordance with paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986

As you will note from the proposals, I do not believe there is a prospect of any funds becoming available to unsecured creditors other than by virtue of the prescribed part. As a consequence, I do not propose to summon a meeting of creditors. If, however, creditors whose debts amount to at least 10% of total debts of any of the companies make a request in the prescribed form within 8 business days of these proposals being sent out, a meeting will be held. A copy of the prescribed form (Form 2.21B) is enclosed in case you wish to request a meeting. I would draw your attention to the provisions of Rule 2.37 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 which provide that if a meeting is requested, it will only be held if the expenses of summoning and holding such a meeting are paid by the creditor or creditors making the request and if security is first deposited with me for payment. The meeting may subsequently resolve that the expenses of summoning and holding the meeting are paid out of the assets of the company as an expense of the administration.

In the event that a meeting is not held, the proposals will be deemed to be accepted. The Joint Administrators' remuneration and Category 2 disbursements will be agreed with the secured and preferential creditors in accordance with the provisions of Rule 2 106(5A) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.

1. Introduction, background and circumstances giving rise to the appointment

1.1 Introduction

On 9 August 2010 the Group entered administration and RH Kelly and CGJ King were appointed to act as Joint Administrators. This document, including its appendices, constitutes the Joint Administrators' statement of proposals to creditors pursuant to paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 and Rule 2 33 of the Insolvency Rules 1986.

Certain statutory information relating to the Group and the appointment of the Joint Administrators is provided at Appendix A

We have provided this statement of proposals in a combined form for the Companies as their affairs are inextricably interlinked and to provide creditors with a greater understanding of the overall situation

1.2 Background


The Group's principal operations are the wholesale distribution of light fittings and bulbs to DIY retailers (including B&Q and Focus), homeware retailers and independent retailers

- Ring sells Ring-branded products (light fittings and bulbs) and DIY retailers own brand products to customers in the UK, and
- Trident sells light fittings to customers in the UK, some of which are customer branded

As well as the two trading companies detailed above, the Group also comprises ALG and Ring Group. These companies are holding companies and do not trade

The Group was formed in September 2009 from the merger of the Ring and Trident businesses

The legal structure of the Group is set out below



Ring and Trident's funding is provided by Burdale Financial Limited ("Burdale") via a combined invoice discounting facility and stock financing facility of up to £5m. Saberasu also provided a loan to Ring of \$5m and is the second ranking secured creditor.

1.3 Financial information

1.4 Circumstances Giving Rise to the Appointment of the Administrators

The Group sources product predominantly from the Far East Its main facilities are warehouses and distribution centres in Leeds (Ring) and Manchester (Trident)

In line with the economic downturn the Group's businesses have seen a systematic reduction in sales as well as suffering from pricing pressure. This has led to considerable losses being incurred.

The majority of the Group's purchases are denominated in US\$ but sales are mostly in the UK and denominated in £ Sterling. This has led to exchange rate losses which have compounded the trading loss position.

To address these issues the Group was formed with the intention of generating synergies, growing sales and reducing costs through economies of scale

In addition, the anticipated annual cost savings of c £1m as a result of the merger of the Ring and Trident businesses did not materialise and have compounded the underperformance of the Group

The Group had been trading on extended credit terms with its suppliers for a number of months and numerous suppliers had placed the Group on stop or on pro forma payment terms. In particular, suppliers in China who are on open accounts and whose accounts were significantly overdue, were withholding shipments and documents of title.

Management undertook a series of visits to the Far East suppliers in July 2010 in an attempt to agree a series of payment plans to enable the Group to trade out of its difficulties. As a consequence of these visits it became apparent that a cash injection of c £1 2m was required to meet the payment requirements of the suppliers.

Management informed its funders of the cash requirement and their proposals for bridging the Group through to a potential cash injection. However due to the risks involved and the lack of any certainty, the funders concluded that they could not agree to continue to support the Group.

On 6 August 2010, the directors concluded that the Group could not continue to trade outside of a formal insolvency process and invited Burdale to appoint R H Kelly and C G J King as Joint Administrators, with the appointment being made on 9 August 2010 in the High Court of Justice, Chancery Division, Leeds District Registry

2. Purpose, conduct and end of the administrations

Purpose of the administration

The purpose of an administration is to achieve one of three objectives

- a To rescue the company as a going concern
- b To achieve a better result for the company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up (without first being in administration)
- c To realise property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors

Insolvency legislation provides that objective (a) should be pursued unless it is not reasonably practicable to do so or if objective (b) would achieve a better result for the company's creditors as a whole. Objective (c) may only be pursued if it is not reasonably practicable to achieve either objective (a) or (b) and can be pursued without unnecessarily harming the interests of the creditors of the company as a whole

The Administrators have concluded that it is not reasonably practicable to achieve the rescue of the Companies as a going concern in accordance with paragraph 3(1)(a) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 as

- the Companies are loss making with substantial obligations to creditors, and
- the Administrators do not consider it possible to find an investor willing to fund these obligations given the viability of the business

The Administrators are therefore pursuing the objective of achieving a better result for the Companies' creditors as a whole than would be likely if the Companies were wound up, without first being in Administration If this is not achievable the Administrators will look to achieve objective (c)

Conduct of the administrations

Sale of the business

Our primary strategy was to sell the business of the Group as a going concern within six weeks of our appointment, prior to the expiry of the rent free period on 28 September 2010 Therefore, immediately on our appointment as Joint Administrators, we marketed the Group for sale

We identified 35 interested parties through discussions with management, an advertisement placed in the Financial Times on 13 August 2010 and additional research

The expressions of interest received were for Ring and Trident's stock and not for the Group's businesses as a whole and a sale as a going concern was not able to be completed

Asset realisations

As there was no interest in the Group's businesses as a going concern, we pursued a strategy of seeking offers for the stock and negotiating with the Group's key customers and debtors to reach compromise agreements to maximise realisations before the expiry of the rent free period in the Leeds warehouse

A reduced workforce of 61 employees has been retained to assist with the realisation of stock and collection of trade debtors. Accordingly, 63 redundancies were made across all areas of the business.

Stock

At the date of our appointment the Group's systems indicated that stock of £4 5m was held at the Leeds site including c 2,900 SKUs with no stock at the Manchester site. This figure included c £1 8m of SKUs which the Group had identified as discontinued or clearance lines.

Therefore, the Group held £2 7m of current and ongoing SKUs, primarily comprising

- £1 1m of stock for B&Q,
- £1 0m of stock for Focus,
- £0 4m of Trident's stock, and
- £0 2m of stock for independent customers

The Group also had c £1 8m of stock in transit from the Far East, however we have not yet received the documents of title in relation to the majority of this stock and would need to make payments to the Chinese suppliers or freight forwarders in order to obtain these documents

Trading has been limited to fulfilling orders to the customers that have signed up to our revised terms and conditions which can be fulfilled using the current stocks in the Leeds warehouse. In order to reduce ongoing trading risk, we agreed with customers that all future supplies would be payable on shortened credit terms.

Ring and Trident currently have significant long term contracts in place with B&Q and Focus We have reached agreement with both B&Q and Focus for the supply of the stock referred to above and anticipate that all of this stock will have been collected by 17 September 2010

Given the expiry of the rent free period on 28 September and the potential requirement to pay a full quarter's rent of £125,000 on 29 September, we intend for the Companies to cease to require the Leeds site by 28 September 2010 unless we can reach an acceptable rent concession with the landlord Following the final despatch of the B&Q and Focus stock on 17 September we will instruct our agents to remove as much of the remaining stock as possible by 28 September 2010 and subsequently dispose of the stock by auction

Short term funding has been provided to the Joint Administrators by Burdale to cover cash flow requirements to enable the limited trading. This funding was provided in accordance with Burdale's normal commercial terms.

Debtors

Debtors at the date of appointment totalled £6 1m. However, this was before deduction of a number of rebates, debit notes and provisions which have been identified during our work. We estimate that the net value of the debtor ledger at the date of our appointment was £4 6m.

The Group's trade debtors are subject to an invoice discounting facility with Burdale Accordingly, the trade debtor balances have been assigned to Burdale. The Joint Administrators are assisting with the collection of the debtor ledger and have engaged Largo to assist in this process.

To date debtor collections amount to £1 7m and we continue to assist in negotiating the collection of the debts in order to maximise the potential overall realisations

Chattel assets

Fixed assets of £1 0m principally comprise plant and machinery, office equipment and fixtures and fittings. This has been professionally valued and the realisable value is £29,000 ex situ but £135,000 in situ.

Administrators' receipts and payments

A summary of the Administrators' receipts and payments for the period from 9 August 2010 to 8 September 2010 is attached at Appendix D. There have been no receipts or payments for Ring Group or ALG.

Initial meeting of creditors

The Joint Administrators are of the opinion that the Companies have insufficient property to enable a distribution to be made to unsecured creditors other than by virtue of the prescribed part and consequently, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 52(1) of Schedule B1 to the Act, they do not intend to call initial creditors' meetings

The Joint Administrators will be obliged to call an initial meeting of creditors if it is requested by creditors of the Company whose debts amount to at least 10% of the total debts of the Company. The request must be made within 8 business days of the date on which these proposals are sent out (or such longer period as the court may allow) and must be in the prescribed form. The creditor summoning the meeting must lodge with the Joint Administrators a deposit as security for the expenses of summoning and holding the meeting Further information is provided in the covering letter accompanying these proposals.

Future conduct of the administration

- ▶ It is proposed that the Joint Administrators will continue to manage the affairs, business and property of the Companies in order to achieve the purpose of the Administration This will include, inter alia
 - Realising the remaining assets, principally the book debts and stock,
 - ► Agreeing preferential creditor claims,
 - ► Conducting investigations into the conduct of the Directors and Management of the Company and reporting to the Department of Business, Enterprise and Regulatory pursuant to the Company Directors Disgualification Act,
 - Distributing the realisations to the secured and preferential creditors,
 - Dealing with unsecured creditor enquines,
 - If appropriate agree unsecured creditor claims and distribute the Prescribed Part,

- Dealing with statutory reporting and compliance obligations, and
- Finalising the Administration including payment of all Administration liabilities

The Leasehold Property

Ring occupies leasehold premises on Gelderd Road, Leeds under a lease agreement dated 23 September 2009 A full quarter's rent payment of £125,000 plus VAT is due to be paid on 29 September 2010 The Companies will only require continued occupation of the premises for a matter of weeks rather than months and consequently we have approached the Landlord's agents, Workman LLP, with a view to reaching agreement for continued occupation beyond 29 September 2010 on a weekly basis rather than a quarterly basis. To date, the Landlord has not been willing to agree to the this basis of occupation

The Joint Administrators are in the process of transferring the stock to customers or to alternative storage facilities. As this process continues during September, the net realisable value of the stock that is expected to remain in the premises at 28 September 2010 is insufficient and make it uneconomical for the Companies to continue to occupy the premises on the terms required by the Landlord. Consequently, if agreement cannot be reached with the Landlord, it is the Joint Administrators' intention to be in a position to exit the Administration of Ring (and any other company within the Group as deemed appropriate) via Liquidation prior to 29 September 2010 and to immediately disclaim the lease as onerous property

The end of the administrations

Ring and Trident

Liquidation

If it is not possible for the Joint Administrators to agree terms with the Landlord for Ring's or Trident's continued occupation of the premises beyond 28 September 2010, it is proposed that the Joint Administrators will petition the court, pursuant to paragraph 79 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, for an order to bring the administration of Ring and/or Trident to an end with a consequential order for the winding up of Ring and/or Trident

If a winding up order of Ring and/or Trident is made, it will be our intention for RH Kelly and CGJ King to be appointed as Joint Liquidators of Ring and Trident

Dissolution

Alternatively, if the Joint Administrators reach agreement with the Landlord for Ring's or Trident's continued occupation of the premises beyond 28 September 2010, but at the end of the Administration Ring and/or Trident have no property which might permit a distribution to its creditors, the Joint Administrators will send a notice to that effect to the registrar of companies. On registration of the notice the Joint Administrators' appointment will come to an end. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 84(6) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 Ring and/or Trident will be deemed to be dissolved three months after the registration of the notice.

ALG and Ring Group

If at the end of the Administrations ALG and Ring Group have no property which might permit a distribution to its creditors, the Joint Administrators will send a notice to that effect to the registrar of companies. On registration of the notice the Joint Administrators' appointment will come to an end. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 84(6) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 ALG and Ring Group will be deemed to be dissolved three months after the registration of the notice.

3. Statement of Affairs

The directors have not yet submitted a Statement of Affairs due to the limited financial resources available and the Group's accounting system which requires the balance sheets to be disaggregated. In the absence of a Statement of Affairs, we attach at Appendix B an estimate of the Group's financial position as at 9 August 2010 together with a list of creditors at Appendix E including, as far as is currently known, their names, addresses, amounts owed and details of any security held

We provide below, for information, an indication of the current position with regard to creditors' claims. The figures have been compiled by Group management and have not been subject to independent review or statutory audit.

Secured creditors

Burdale, the Group's principal secured lender, had total indebtedness at 9 August 2010 of £4,356,000

In addition, the second ranking secured lender, Saberasu, had total indebtedness at the date of our appointment of \$5 0m plus accrued interest

However, the above amounts are subject to accruing interest and charges

Preferential creditors

We currently estimate preferential creditors of £125,000, in respect of claims for employees' salaries, holiday pay and pension contributions

Non-preferential creditors

These creditor claims continue to be submitted. It is estimated that total non-preferential claims will be in the region of c $\pounds 4m$

While the above information has been provided for the Group, the existence of crossguarantees to both Burdale and Saberasu mean that a similar position for the unsecured creditors is shown for each Company

4. Prescribed part

The prescribed part is a proportion of floating charge assets set aside for unsecured creditors pursuant to section 176A of the Insolvency Act 1986. The prescribed part applies to floating charges created on or after 15 September 2003.

The Joint Administrators estimate, to the best of their knowledge and belief, that

- ► The value of the Group's net property is £676,000
- ► The value of the prescribed part is £138,000, before the costs of dealing with the prescribed part

The prescribed part of the Group is based on the combined position of Ring and Trident Until the balance sheets are disaggregated it will not be possible to allocate this figure between the two companies. However the majority of the prescribed part will be available to the unsecured creditors of Ring.

The Joint Administrators do not currently intend to make an application to the court under section 176A(5) of the Insolvency Act 1986 for an order not to distribute the prescribed part However depending upon the final quantification of all unsecured claims for a particular company, the payment of a dividend in respect of the prescribed part may be uneconomical. The Administrators therefore reserve the right to make such application to the court in these circumstances.

5. Administrators' remuneration and disbursements and payments to other professionals

Remuneration

The statutory provisions relating to remuneration are set out in Rule 2 106 of the Insolvency Rules 1986. Further information is given in the Association of Business Recovery Professionals' publication 'A Creditors' Guide to Administrators' Fees', a copy of which may be accessed from the web site of the Insolvency Practitioners Association at http://www.insolvency-practitioners.org.uk (follow 'Regulation and Guidance" then 'Creditors' Guides to Fees'), or is available in hard copy upon written request to the Joint Administrators

In the event that a creditors' meeting is not requisitioned and a creditors' committee is not formed, the Joint Administrators will seek to have their remuneration fixed by the secured creditor(s) and if the Joint Administrators have made or intend to make a distribution to preferential creditors, the preferential creditors in accordance with Rule 2 106(5A) of the Rules. The Joint Administrators will ask for their remuneration to be fixed on the basis of time properly given by them and their staff in dealing with matters arising in the Administration.

Attached at Appendix C is a detailed analysis of time spent and charge out rates, for each grade of staff for the various areas of work carried out to 3 September 2010, as required by the Association of Business Recovery Professionals' Statement of Insolvency Practice No 9

Disbursements

Appendix C also includes a statement of the Joint Administrators' policy for charging disbursements. In the event that a creditors' meeting is not requisitioned and a creditors' committee is not formed, the Joint Administrators will seek the approval of the secured creditors and the preferential creditors to charge Category 2 disbursements

Pre administration costs

On 28 July 2010, Ernst & Young LLP were engaged by Burdale to undertake a contingency planning exercise in the event of an insolvency of the Group. In the period between 28 July 2010 and 9 August 2010, Ernst & Young LLP charged fees of £25,000 in respect of this work which were paid by Burdale and debited to the Group's accounts under the terms of the Group's facility agreement. Time costs incurred were in excess of the amount billed and the balance of unpaid time costs has been written off.

This work was undertaken in order that any subsequent administration appointment was undertaken in a controlled manner and the assets of the Group could be secured immediately on our appointment as Joint Administrators
