Short particulars

2 By way of floating charge all the other property assets and rights of the Company owned now or in the future which are not subject to an effective fixed charge under the Debenture or any other security held by the Bank

Note 1 The Debenture contains covenants by the Company that the Company will not without the Bank's consent - (a) permit to create any mortgage, standard security, charge or lien on the property, (b) dispose of the property of the Company, owned now or in the future, charged by way of fixed charge,

(c) dispose of the property, other than in the ordinary course of business, charged by way of floating charge

(d) call on, or accept payment of, any uncalled capital,

(e) deal with its book and other debts, except by collecting them in the ordinary course of business. In particular, the Company will not realise its book and other debts by means of invoice discounting or factoring arrangements,

(f) grant, or accept a surrender of, any lease or licence of any of its Land or consent to a tenant assigning or sub letting,

(g) dispose of, part with a share possession or occupation of any of its Land
