E P PACKAGING LIMITED (IN ADMINISTRATION) ("THE COMPANY")

I write pursuant to Rule 2.110 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 to report to creditors on the progress of the Administration.

I enclose a receipts and payments account for the period to 19 December 2008.

Statutory Information

The company was incorporated on 7 March 1953 under number 00516832.

The registered office of the company was Queensway Industrial Estate, Wrexham, Clwyd, LL13 8YR although it has been changed to the offices of Moore Stephens LLP, Beaufort House, 94-96 Newhall Street, Birmingham, B3 1PB for the purposes of the administration.

Nigel Price and Colin Andrew Prescott were appointed Joint Administrators to the company on 20 June 2008 by the directors of the company. The appointment documentation was lodged in the High Court of Justice, Birmingham District Registry case number 9255 of 2008.

Asset Realisations

The sale of the business to Anson Wrexham ("Ansons") realised the sum of £613,890 details of which have already been provided in my report to all creditors dated 24 July 2008.

At the date of my appointment, outstanding trade debtors totalled £1,157,000. These debtors were subject to a confidential Discount Agreement with The Royal Bank of Scotland Plc ("RBS") who were owed the sum of £806,249.

Since the date of my appointment, trade debtor collections have realised £981,886 and therefore there is a surplus as regards RBS of £175,637. There is approximately a further £38,000 still to be collected. During the course of my collections, I have had to write off approximately £137,000 due to disputed or bad debts.

Cash at bank realised the sum of £5,424.

There have been sundry receipts totalling £3,776 comprising of a refund of business rates from Wrexham County Council and a refund from Pitney Bowes in respect of the company's franking account.

Interest has been received of £8,470.

Receipts and Payments

The costs of the administration and the payments that have been made are set out clearly in the attached document and are self explanatory. Should you require any further explanation, please contact me.

Chargeholder

National Westminster Bank Plc ("Nat West") who held the first floating charge were owed the sum of £78,015 as at the date of my appointment and they have now been paid in full from floating charge realisations.

Redbrick Estates Limited ("Redbrick") have been paid the sum of £250,000 under their debenture which ranked for distribution after Nat West's charge. I anticipate that I will be in a position to make a further payment to them of approximately £200,000 in due course which will leave them with a shortfall of approximately £615,000.

Dividend prospects for Creditors

There are no preferential creditors as all employees were transferred across to Ansons as part of the sale. As such, there will be no employee claims in the proceedings.

The Enterprise Act 2002 introduced legislation to provide, in certain circumstances, a fund for unsecured creditors from the assets of the company, which would otherwise be available to a floating chargeholder. This is known as the prescribed part.

As Redbrick's charge was created after 15 September 2003, a prescribed part payment to unsecured creditors is due. Based upon the figures initially supplied to us by the directors, I would anticipate that I will be in a position to make a small prescribed part distribution of approximately 10p in the £ to unsecured creditors. As such, I will shortly be forwarding claim forms for you to complete and return to my office in order that you may lodge your claim in the proceedings.

Liquidation

To facilitate the prescribed part distribution to unsecured creditors it is necessary for me to place the company into liquidation. A resolution was passed to this effect as part of my proposals which were approved by creditors on 26 August 2008.

In order to place the company into liquidation all that is required is for me to lodge Form 2.34b at Companies House which I now intend to do. A copy of this form is attached for your information.

The company will then automatically be placed into creditors' voluntary liquidation. I will report to you once this has occurred and, will provide you with a proof of debt form at that time to facilitate your claim.



Remuneration and disbursements

A resolution for time costs and category 2 disbursements was approved at the paragraph 51 meeting held on 26 August 2008.

My firm's time costs to date total £72,622.20. This is made up of post appointment work of £57,963.85 and pre appointment work of £14,658.35, a breakdown is set out in Appendix A. This represents 403.95 hours at an average hourly rate of £143.49. To date I have drawn the sum of £62,438.70 which includes £7,500 for pre appointment time. The disbursements to date total £1,886.57, a breakdown is set out in Appendix B. To date I have drawn the sum of £1,878.42. These fees and expenses have already been ratified by Redbrick.
