REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st DECEMBER 1975

1. **ACTIVITIES:** The principal activities of the Company during the year have been the marketing of excavator spares and the provision of after-sales service on behalf of J.C. Bamford Excavators Limited.

Bamford Excavators Limited which is in addition to the 6% it already held. The purchase consideration was satisfied by the issue of 38,709 ordinary shares of £1 each fully paid.


