NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 OCTOBER 1975

#### 1 ACCOUNTING FOLICIES

#### (1) Deferred taxation

Provision is made for deferred taxation arising from timing differences between profits as computed for taxation purposes and profits as stated in the accounts. Timing differences are due primarily to the excess of tax allowances on fixed assets over the corresponding depreciation charged in the accounts. The provision is calculated each year on the deferral basis.

## (2) Internal professional fees and pre-opening expenses

Internal professional costs incurred during the construction of Motorway Service Areas are capitalised. In addition preopening and development expenses incurred up to the date of opening are deferred and written off over five years.

#### (3) Depreciation

No depreciation is provided on freehold properties or properties held on leases with fifty years and over to run at the balance sheet date. Properties held on leases of less than fifty years are amortised over the unexpired term. All other assets are depreciated over their estimated useful lives except for plate, linen and utensils which are stated at directors' valuation, replacements being charged against profits.

#### (4) Stock valuation

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

## CHANGE IN BASIS RELATING TO DEFERRED TAXATION

In accordance with now generally accepted accounting principles, a deferred taxation basis of accounting has been adopted as indicated in Note 1.

The new basis has been reflected in previous years by an appropriate re-statement, the effect on retained profits being as follows:
