the company will not carry on business or operate in any way other than to take the necessary steps to (i) transfer the payment covenant, in respect of the land registered at HM Land Registry under title number SY613450, to Sunley Estates Limited, referred to in paragraph 13 of the Third Witness Statement of James Bernard Sunley dated the 21st September 2018 (ii) settle all outstanding debts to its existing creditors, if any; and (iii) distribute the remaining balance of proceeds received from the said transfer (the actions) according to law.


- (B) they will notify the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the actions.
- (C) the directors of the company will immediately on the expiry of 3 months from the conclusion of the actions apply to the Registrar of Companies for the voluntary strike off of the company under Section 1003 of the Companies Act 2006 and comply with all the relevant requirements for such an application.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) the name of the above named Sunley Priestgate Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 00692859 Limited
- (3) an Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

(5) the hearing fixed for the 18th October 2018 be vacated
