INTRODUCTION

Thames Water Products Overseas Limited (Entity) entered members' voluntary liquidation on 26 March 2019. Emma Cray and David Matthew Hammond were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This account covers the conduct and progress of the liquidation in the period from 26 March 2019 to 25 March 2020 (Period). This is the Liquidators' final account of the liquidation and also serves as a progress report 26 March 2019 to 25 March 2020.

A summary of receipts and payments in the liquidation is at Appendix A.

The statutory information relating to the Entity and the Liquidators is at Appendix B.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency showed that the Company's assets were Nil.

No additional assets have been identified. There are no assets still to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency showed that the Entity had no liabilities.

In the Period, the Liquidators published a notice in the London Gazette inviting creditors to submit details of claims they may have against the Entity.

The Liquidators have not received any claims in the liquidation.

HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"):

Following their appointment, the Liquidators wrote to HMRC to inform them of the liquidation and to request details of any outstanding liabilities. HMRC have confirmed that the Entity has no outstanding tax liabilities and that they have no objection to the liquidation being closed.

We were advised pre-liquidation that the Companies were tax dormant. We duly notified HMRC of our appointment and as a result received clearance from HMRC on 16 May 2019. During the liquidation, but after HMRC clearance was received, we were made aware that just prior to the liquidation a number of transactions occurred to clear down the balance sheet ahead of our appointment as liquidators. Whilst the companies tax advisors believe that these are tax neutral, for completeness, we have subsequently submitted nil returns reflecting these transactions.

We have not received further clearance, however on submission of the final tax computations, we gave HMRC the opportunity to retract the clearance. No objection to us proceeding to close has been received from HMRC and as such we are intending to proceed to close relying on the previously received clearance.

Distributions to Members:

At the time of our appointment, the issued share capital of the Company consisted of £25,000 £1 Ordinary shares.

On 24 June 2019, we made a distribution in specie of £1 (representing 100 pence per share) to the shareholder.

The distribution in specie consisted of an inter-group debtor balance together with any other assets held by the Company. The value attributed to the in specie distribution was based on the value held at which the asset was held in the Company's books.

LIQUIDATORS' FEES AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration

The basis of the Liquidators' remuneration has been fixed by reference to the time properly given by them and their staff in dealing with the liquidation, in accordance with a resolution dated 26 March 2019.

Liquidators' remuneration

As there were no funds in the estate, the Entity's Member , Thames Water Limited, agreed to settle all costs associated with the liquidation of the Entity and 2 other connected entities.

The Liquidators have invoiced £15,000 plus VAT in the Period in respect of the Entity and 2 connected entities.

In respect of the entire period of the liquidation of the Entity and 2 connected entities, the Liquidators' fees total £19,714 plus VAT to date. We estimate the liquidators costs to close will be £2,700 + VAT.

Liquidators' expenses1

The Liquidators have incurred the following expenses in connection with the liquidation of the Entity and 2 connected entities. Thames Water Limited has settled such expenses plus VAT.
