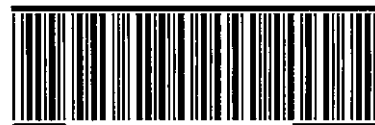



**Notes**
