1 Principal accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

Basis of accounting

These financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable UK accounting standards.

Group accounts

The company is exempt under section 400 of Companies Act 2006 from the requirement to prepare group financial statements and deliver them to the Registrar of Companies. The company is included in the consolidated financial statements of Carillion plc, the company's ultimate parent undertaking which is registered in England and Wales.
