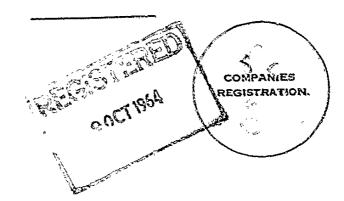

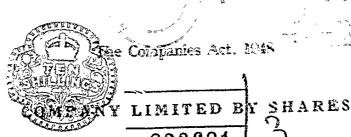

15.—(1) A Cortificate of Incorporation given by the Registrar in respect of any Association shall be conclusive evidence that all the requirements of this Act in respect of registration and of matters precedent and incidental thereto have been complied with, and that the Association is a Company authorised to be registered and duly registered under this Act.

(2) A Statutory Declaration by a Solicitor of the Supreme Court, and in Scotlend by a Solicitor, engaged in the formation of the Company, or by a person named in the Articles as a Director or Secretary of the Company, of formation of the Company, ar by a person named in the Articles as a Director of Secretary and the Registrar may accept compliance with all or any of the said requirements shall be produced to the Registrar, and the Registrar may accept such a Declaration as sufficient evidence of compliance.

OF

SEVERN SHIRTS LIMITED.

- 1. The Name of the Company is "SEVERN SHIRTS LIMITED".
- 2. The Registered Office of the Company will be situate in England.
- 3. The Objects for which the Company is established are:-
- (A) To carry on the businesses of Manufacturers, Repairers, Renovators, and Factors of, Agents for, and Dealers in Shirts, Collars, Pyjamas, Jeans, Overalls, Leisure Wear, and other articles of apparel of all descriptions, and to carry on all or any of the businesses of Silk Mercers, Silk Weavers, Cotton Spinners and Doublers, Flax, Hemp, and Jute Spinners, Linen Manufacturers, Flax, Hemp, Jute, and Wool Merchants, Wool Combers, Worsted Spinners, Wool and Yarn Merchants, Worsted Stuff Manufacturers, Bleachers, and Dyers, and Makers of Vitriol, Bleaching and Dyeing materials, and to purchase, comb, prepare, spin, dye and deal in flax, hemp, jute, wool, cotton, silk (natural and artificial), and other fibrous substances, and to weave or otherwise manufacture, buy and sell, and deal in liner, cloth and other goods and fabrics, whether textile, felted, netted, or looped; Milliners, Dressmakers, Tailors, Hatters, Clothiers, Outfitters, Glovers, Lace Manufacturers, Leather Dressers, Tanners, Dealers in Hides, Skins, and other materials, and Manufacturers of and Dealers in Rubber Goods; and to carry og the business of a Steam and General Laundry and to wash, clean, purify, scour, bleach, wring, dry, iron, colour, dye, disinfect, renovate and prepare for use all articles of wearing apparel, household, domestic and other linen and cotton and woollen goods and clothing and fabrics of all kinds.
 - (B) To buy, sell, hire, let on hire, manufacture, repair, renovate, alter, and exchange, improve, treat, and d al in apperatus, machines, materials, goods, and articles of all kinds which may be required or are commonly supplied or dealt in by persons engaged in any such businesses, or which may seem capable of being used or dealt in for any such purposes or

businesses.

TOCTION

- (C) To carry on any cher business which may seem to the Company capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above objects, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render more profitable any of the Company's property.
- (D) To purchase or otherwise acquire any freehold or leasehold property, and any real or personal property or rights whatsoever.
- (E) To build, construct, maintain, alter enlarge, pull down, and remove or replace any buildings.
- (F) To acquire and undertake the whole or any part of the business, goodwill, assets and limbilities of any person, firm, or company, and to acquire an interest in, amalgamate with, or enter into partnership or into any other arrangement with any person, firm, or company.
- (G) To improve, manage, develop, exchange, let on lease or otherwise, mortgage, charge, sell, dispose of, turn to account, grant rights and privileges in respect of, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property and rights of the Company.
- (H) To invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required in such shares or upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (I) To lend and advance money or give credit to any persons, firms, or companies, and to give guarantees or become security for any persons, firms, or companies.
- (J) To borrow or raise money in such manner as the Company shall think fit.

- (K) To draw, make, accept, enuorse, discount, execute, and issue negotiable or transferable instruments of any kind.
- (L) To subscribe for or otherwise acquire shares or other interests in or securities of any other company.
- (M) To act as agents or brokers and as trustees for any person, firm, or company, and to undertake and perform sub-contracts, and also to act in any of the businesses of the Company through or by means of agents, brokers, sub-contractors, or others.
- (N) To remunerate any person, firm, or company rendering services to this Company.
- (O) To pay all or any expenses incurred in connection with the promotion, formation, and incorporation of the Company.

- (P) To support and subscribe to any charitable or public object, and any institution, society, or club which may be for the benefit of the Company or its employes; to give pensions, gratuities, or charitable aid to and to form and contribute to provident and benefit funds for the benefit of any persons who are or have been Directors of or who are serving or have served the Company, or to their wives, children, or other relatives or dependents; and to make payments towards insurance.
 - (Q) To promote any companies.
 - (R) To sell or otherwise dispose of the whole or any part of the business or property of the Company.
 - (S) To distribute among the Members of the Company in kind any property of the Company.
 - (T) To do all such other things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

It is hereby expressly declared that each Sub-Clause of this Clause shall be construed independently of the other Sub-Clauses hereof, and that none of the objects mentioned in any Sub-Clause shall be deemed to be merely subsidiary to the objects mentioned in any other Sub-Clause.

- 4. The Liability of the Mcmbers is Limited.
- 5. The Share Capital of the Company is £100, divided into One Hundred Shares of £1 each.

Articles of Association

SEVERN SHIRTS LIMITED. OOCT 1964

- 1. The regulations contained in Part I of Table A in the First Schedule to The Companies Act, 1948 (such Table being hereinafter called "Table A"), shall apply to the Company save in so far as they are excluded or varied hereby: that is to say, Clauses 24, 53, 75 and 77 in Part I of Table A shall not apply to the Company; and in addition to the remaining Clauses in Part I of Table A, as varied by these Articles, the following shall be the regulations of the Company.
- 2. The Company is a Private Company and Clauses 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 (but not Clause 1) in Part II of Table A shall also apply to the Company.
- 3. The Shares shall be under the control of the Directors, who may allot and dispose of or grant options over the same. to such persons, on such terms, and in such manner as they think fit.
- 4. The lien conferred by Clause 11 in Part I of Table A shall attach to fully paid up Shares, and to all Shares registered in the name of any person indebted or under liability to the Company, whether he shall be the sole registered holder thereof or shall be one of two or more joint holders.
- 5. Every notice convening a General Meeting shall comply with the provisions of Section 136 (2) of The Companies Act, 1948, as to giving information to Members in regard to their right to appoint proxies; and notices of and other communications relating to any General Meeting which any Member is entitled to receive shall be sent to the Auditor for the time being of the Company.
 - 6. Clause 54 in Part I of Table A shall be read and construed as if the words "Meeting shall be dissolved" were substituted for the words "Members present shall be a quorum".
- 7. If at any General Meeting a poll is duly demanded on a resolution to remove a Permanent Director from office, such

Permanent Director shall on the poll being taken be entitled to ten votes for each Share of which he is the holder; and Clause 62 in Part I of Table A shall be modified accordingly. Any motion for the removal of two or more Permanent Directors from office shall be submitted to the Meeting as a separate resolution in respect of each of such Directors.

- S. Unless and until the Company in General Meeting shall otherwise determine, the number of Directors shall be not less than two nor more than five.
- 9. The following persons shall be the first Directors of the Company: Miss Nancy Dorrell of No. 30, Britannia Square, Worcester and Mr. Philip George Dorrell of Cove Cottage, Northwich, Worcester. They shall be Permanent Directors of the Company, and subject to the provisions of Clause 88 in Part I of Table A each of them shall be entitled to hold such office so long as she or he shall live unless she or he shall be removed from office under Clause 96 in Part I of Table A; and accordingly Clauses 89 to 94 in Part I of Table A shall not apply to any Permanent Director.
 - 10. Clause 79 in Part I of Table A shall be read and construed as if the proviso to such Clause were omitted therefrom.
 - 11. A Director may vote as a Director in regard to any contract or arrangement in which he is interested or upon any matter arising thereout, and if he shall so vote his vote shall be counted and he shall be reckoned in estimating a quorum when any such contract or arrangement is under consideration; and Clause 84 in Part I of Table A shall be modified accordingly.
