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REPORT OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST JANUARY 2018

The members of the Council of Westminster Productions present their report and financial statements for the year ended 31st January 2018.

Principal Activities

The Company's principal activity continues to be that of advancing the Christian religion through the production of plays and literary works, which will encourage people to live in accordance with the principles of the Christian religion. Westminster Productions supports plays and drama projects which express Christian truth in a way that speaks to the modern secular world. Such projects give people a moral framework, which enables them to better play a positive role in society. One of the playwrights summed this up by writing in the theatre programme, "I write my plays to encourage the growth of character that is essential if civilisation is to survive".

Plays

The Charity continues to support Intermission Youth Theatre, a London based Christian theatre company which works with young people at risk, through drama and particularly Shakespeare. This project gives the young people a sense of their self-worth and their valued place as members of the drama company. By extension and by examining how the issues raised in Shakespeare's plays relate to their own lives, it encourages young people to achieve their full potential and take a responsible part in society.

Westminster Productions Ltd. is currently engaged in a project to preserve the theatre sets and paintings of William Cameron-Johnson, artwork that continues to demonstrate the Christian roots of the West's theatrical heritage.
