IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

- 1. LEAD APPLICANT'S REMOVAL AS OFFICE HOLDER
 - 1.1 The Lead Applicant be removed as office holder in the cases set out in the Schedules hereto pursuant to the relevant power set opposite each category below with effect from the date of this Order:-
