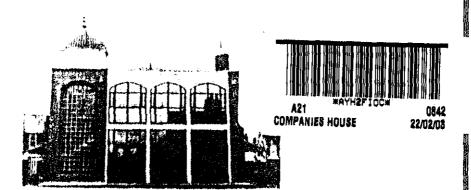

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention.

(b) Depreciation

Depreciation is not provided on freehold buildings, contrary to the accounting standards as laid down by SSAP 12.

If depreciation was provided for, the charge would have been £ 472 (2001: £472).

(c) Value added tax

Items in the financial statements are shown inclusive of value added tax.

(d) Donations

Donations are accounted for on a cash received basis.
