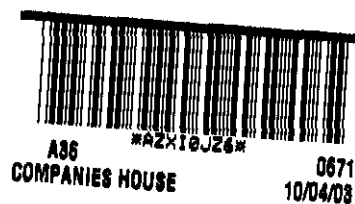

## Notes to the Accounts - 31 December 2002

### 1 Ownership

Automobile Association Travel Services Limited is an indirect wholly owned subsidiary undertaking of GB Gas Holdings Limited. At the balance sheet date, GB Gas Holdings Limited was a wholly owned subsidiary undertaking of Centrica plc, the ultimate parent company at that date.
