GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The Trust is a company limited by guarantee and registered as a Charity. The Charity's objects, powers and proceedings are governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association.

The policies adopted in furtherance of these objects are laid down in the Statement of Purpose and there have been no changes to these during the year.

Organisation

The charity transferred it assets and liabilities to The Brendoncare Foundation on 7 February 2008. Both Charities are based in Winchester and have a long and shared history as well as closely shared values and ethos. It had always been the original intention of the founding Trustees that the two charities should act as one.

Since that date the Charity has not traded. The Home at Park Road that was previously run by the Charity is now run by The Brendoncare Foundation. The Company remains in existence but only for the purpose of receiving donations under existing arrangements with any surplus being subsequently transferred to the Brendoncare Foundation.

On 18 November 2008 the Charity became a 100% subsidiary of The Brendoncare Foundation.

Since the charity became a subsidiary of The Brendoncare Foundation there has been a sole Trustee. The Trustee of the Charity is appointed and removed by the Foundation and is also a trustee of the Foundation. In the event of potential conflicts of interest between the Charity and the Foundation, the policy agreed by both parties is that the Charity's

trustee will act solely for the Charity and will not participate in the decisions made by the Foundation. No such potential conflicts arose during the year to 31 March 2019.

Trustees

The Trustees who are also the directors for the purpose of company law, who served during the year, were:

Mr N Capon

The Trustee does not have any beneficial interest in the company. The parent company, The Brendoncare Foundation, is the sole member of the company and guarantees to contribute $\pounds 1$ in the event of a winding up.

Trustee Induction and Training

The Charity has one Trustee who is also a Trustee of the parent company, The Brendoncare Foundation. Trustees of The Brendoncare Foundation receive induction training provided by the Foundation's and Charity's staff, and attend regular development sessions, provided by staff and third party experts, to enhance their understanding of issues faced by the Charity. On appointment, Trustees receive a handbook containing a broad range of information aimed at assisting them to gain a deeper and more structured understanding of their role and of the Charity, including a copy of the Memorandum and Articles of Association and the Report and Accounts.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The Charity has not traded during the period.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The Charity has not traded during the period.

Reserves policy

The charity has transferred all its assets and liabilities to The Brendoncare Foundation and so has no reserves at the end of the year.

Statement of Trustees Responsibilities

The Trustee (who is also a director of Brendon Nursing Trust Limited for the purposes of company law) is responsible for preparing the Report of the Trustees and financial statements in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice). Company law require the Trustee to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Company and of the incoming resources and the application of resources, including the income and expenditure, of the Charitable Company for that period.

In preparing these financial statements, the Trustee is required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- observe the methods and principles of the Charities SORP;
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Charity will continue in business.

The Trustee is responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that disclose, with reasonable accuracy at any time, the financial position of the Charity and enable him to ensure that the financial statements comply with the duty in section 4 of Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2019

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015) - (Charities SORP FRS 102), the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) and the Companies Act 2006.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and include income and expenditure as they are earned or incurred

The accounts cover the year to 31 March 2019, with comparatives for the year to 31 March 2018.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the Charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income:

Donations, legacies and other forms of voluntary income are accounted for gross when receivable.

Donated services and facilities are included at the value to the Charity where this can be quantified. The value of services provided by volunteers has not been included in these financial statements.

Resources expended

Expenditure is recognised on an accruals basis as a liability is incurred. The Charity is not registered for VAT and costs are therefore shown inclusive of VAT.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the Charity in the delivery of its activities and services for its beneficiaries.

Governance costs include those costs associated with meeting the constitutional and statutory requirements of the Charity and include audit fees and costs linked with the strategic management of the Charity.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the Charity.

2 TRUSTEES' EMOLUMENTS AND INDEMNITY INSURANCE

No remuneration was paid or due to the Trustee during the year (2018: £nil). The Trustee was not reimbursed for any expenses incurred (2018: £nil).

The Brendoncare Foundation maintains indemnity insurance to protect the Company and to indemnify Trustees, Officers and Staff against the consequences of any neglect or default on their part. The cost involved is £3,724 (2018: £3,724).

3 TAXATION

As a Charity the company is exempt from taxation on income and gains and so no provision for taxation is considered necessary.
