The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation showed a debt due from The Peninsular and Oriental Steam Navigation Company, the Company's immediate parent. The debt will be distributed by set off prior to the closure of the liquidation.

Tax

All pre-liquidation corporation tax matters were handled by the DP World tax team who prepared and submitted all outstanding returns up to the date of the liquidation to HM Revenue & Customs ('HMRC') At the request of the Joint Liquidators, HMRC subsequently confirmed that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the liquidators calling a final meeting of members to conclude the liquidation

A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE

The Company was not registered for VAT
