Matters arising during the year

At the date of liquidation, the Company held, as trustee, £27,285 86 due to 99 non-assenting shareholders whose shares in the Company had been compulsorily acquired by Court Cavendish Plc under section 420 (11) of The Companies Act 1985 following the takeover of the Company in 1996 Following the liquidation, these funds were placed into a separate trust account operated by the liquidators. The former registrars, Equinit, most recently made attempts to trace the non-assenting shareholders in March 2010, and it was not considered appropriate to deplete the funds by another attempt to trace them. The costs of dealing with the non-assenting shareholders further were therefore deducted from the trust fund in accordance with section 430 (11) of The Companies Act 1985, and the balance was paid into court. The Court has acknowledged receipt of these funds.

Matters preventing conclusion of the liquidation

HM Revenue & Customs has lodged a claim in the liquidation in the sum of £621 20. It is unclear what this amount relates to, therefore the liquidators continue to investigate this matter

Distributions

No distributions have been declared during the period

Joint liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 26 May 2010 that the remuneration of the joint liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company.

In the event, the liquidators' remuneration has been paid by The British United Provident Association Limited and accordingly no detailed analysis is included in this report
