UPON THE APPLICATION of the Applicant by notice of application lodged on 17 July 2006

AND UPON HEARING Counsel on behalf of the Applicant, the Respondents neither having appeared nor been represented but having consented in writing to the relief hereinafter granted

AND UPON READING the documents recorded in the Court file as having been read

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

- Time for service of the Applicant's application on the Respondents be abridged.
- In respect of the relevant liquidations, company voluntary arrangements, administrations, and the individual voluntary arrangement identified in the schedule marked "A" attached to this Order as being the subject of proceedings not already within the jurisdiction of the High Court in London, these proceedings be transferred to the High Court in London, Chancery Division, solely for the purpose of considering and if thought fit making the Orders contained in the paragraphs below.
- 3. In relation to all the appointments held jointly by the Applicant in respect of West Walk House Limited (in company voluntary arrangement) and in respect of all the compulsory and creditors' and members' voluntary liquidations identified in the Schedule marked "A" attached, the Applicant be removed from office.
- 4. In relation to all the appointments held solely by the Applicant in respect of the compulsory liquidations and the individual voluntary arrangements identified in Schedule "A" attached, the Applicant be removed from office and the First Respondent be appointed as Office Holder in the Applicant's place.
- 5. In relation to all the appointments held jointly by the Applicant in respect of all the company voluntary arrangements (except in respect of West Walk House Limited referred to in paragraph 3 above) and all administrations identified in Schedule "A" attached, the Applicant be removed from office and the Second Respondent be appointed as Office Holder in the Applicant's place.

- 6. The Respondents shall when the next report is due to the creditors of each liquidation, company voluntary arrangement, administration and individual voluntary arrangement give written notice of the making of this Order to each such creditor of each liquidation, company voluntary arrangement, administration and individual voluntary arrangement, such notice to include the following matters:-
  - (i) An explanation of the effect of the Order.
  - (ii) Express reference to the liberty to apply set out in the Order.
  - (iii) In the case of the voluntary arrangements (company and individual) and the administrations, the provision of all such information as might reasonably be required with regard to the conduct of the arrangements or the administrations (as the case may be).
  - (iv) In the case of the liquidations (including compulsory liquidations) where liquidation or creditors committees have been appointed, an explanation that (to the extent that any information which would otherwise be required to be provided under IR 4.108(3) has not already been provided as part of that report) it is open to the committee to require the Respondent appointed or remaining in office to provide an account of the administration of the estate, including:-
    - (a) A summary of receipts and payments;
    - (b) A statement that he has reconciled his accounts;
  - (v) In the case of the liquidations where no liquidation or creditors committees have been appointed, an explanation that, to the extent that such information has not already been provided as part of the routine report, it is open to any creditor to apply for an order that the Respondent in question do provide such information as might otherwise be required by IR 4.108(3) that is to say an account of the administration of the estate, including:

- (a) A summary of receipts and payments;
- (b) A statement that he has reconciled his accounts.
- (vi) In the case of members voluntary liquidations, an explanation that, to the extent that any information which might otherwise be required to be supplied under IR 4.142(2) has not already been provided as part of the routine report, it is open to any member to apply to Court for an order that the remaining Office Holder do provide such information that is to say an account of the administration of the estate, including:-
  - (a) A summary of receipts and payments
  - (b) A statement that he has reconciled his accounts.
- (vii) Notification that if the Respondent or remaining Office Holder in question has been required to provide the information referred in paragraphs 6(iv), 6(v) and 6(vi) above, whether by the liquidation/creditors committee or by court order on the application of any individual creditor, the Respondent's or remaining Office Holder's costs of complying with such request or order shall, unless good reasons to the contrary are demonstrated, be paid as a cost of the liquidation.
- (viii) In the case of the liquidations, notifications to each creditor of their right under IR 11(1) (compulsory liquidation) and IR 11(2) (voluntary liquidation) of the Insolvency Regulations 1994 to require the Respondent to supply a statement of receipts and payments free of charge.
- 7. Liberty to each creditor of each liquidation, company voluntary arrangement, administration and individual voluntary arrangement to apply to vary or discharge this Order within 21 days of receipt of the notices directed to be sent under paragraph 6 above.
