Notes to the Abbreviated Accounts for the year ended 31st December, 1999

1. Accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been consistently applied in dealing with the items which are considered material in relation to the Company's Accounts.

- 1.1 Basis of preparation the Accounts have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and under the historical cost accounting rules. This has been applied to the Company's operations as described in the Directors' Report, all of which are continuing, on a going concern basis.
- **1.2 Turnover** represents the invoiced total for goods and services provided to customers during the year and excludes Value Added Tax.
- 1.3 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation has been provided by the Company at the rate of 25% on the reducing balances calculated to write off the costs, less the estimated residual values, of all the assets over their expected useful lives. The exception is the freehold property acquired in 1998 which has been maintained and repaired to a standard such that the asset is being kept to its previously assessed standard of performance. A depreciation charge is considered immaterial because of the expected long economic life and high residual value.
- 1.4 Stocks are stated at the lower of cost and net realisable value.
- **1.5** Hire purchase assets obtained under hire purchases have been capitalised as tangible fixed assets and depreciated over their estimated useful lives.
- 1.6 Deferred taxation no provision was considered necessary.
