

1. SUMMARY OF EVENTS

Progress of the liquidation during the report period	 The matters completed during the report period include internal compliance and case reviews, report preparation of the prior year's annual progress report to the member and filings at Companies House. There have been no receipts or payments during the period. No creditor claims were notified to the Liquidators. 						
Costs	Our remuneration was fixed by the member on a time-cost basis and, as there were no funds in the estate, our fees are being settled by HSBC Bank Plc. During the period we have been paid £3,806.30, excluding VAT and disbursements.						
Outstanding matters	HSBC are continuing to investigate and respond on a potential tax matter in relation to the previous transfer of shares in a Saudi venture. They are currently corresponding with the Saudi authorities, through their solicitors and tax agents to progress the matter to a conclusion. HSBC have requested that we keep the liquidation open until such time as the position is confirmed which is expected to be within the next 6 months.						
Distributions made during the period	No distributions were made to the members during the report period.						
Future distributions and closure	 No further distributions are anticipated. It is anticipated that the liquidation will be closed within the next 6 months assuming that the outstanding matters can be resolved.

- 1. At the date of liquidation the only remaining asset was an intercompany receivable of £2 and not the balance of £20,000 shown on the Declaration of Solvency. In the intervening period, between the date up to which the Declaration of Solvency was made and the date of liquidation, a pre-liquidation dividend of £19,998 was declared, and paid.
- 2. A first and final in specie distribution was made to the member on 7 May 2019 when £2 was distributed, which equates to a rate of £2 per Ordinary £1 share.

2.2 Liquidators' Costs and Disbursements

There have been no disbursements incurred in the period.

2.3 Liquidators' Remuneration

As there are no funds in the estate, our fees are being met by a fellow group undertaking, HSBC Bank Plc. During the period we have been paid £3,806.30, excluding VAT and disbursements.
