- a) Basis of accounting -The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.
- b) Cash Flow Statements In accordance with Financial Reporting Standard Number one no cash flow
  statement is included in these financial statements as the company is covered
  by the small company exemption.
- c) Depreciation -Depreciation is provided to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets over their estimated useful lives by equal annual instalments at the following rates:

Freehold buildings - 3% on cost

Leasehold radio stations - over the period of the lease, or expected life if shorter (see note 6 below)

Radio equipment - 4% - 20% on cost

Furniture and equipment - 10% on cost
Motor vehicles - 25% on cost

d) Deferred taxation -Provision is made for taxation deferred in respect of all material timing differences only to the extent that, in the opinion of the directors, there is a reasonable probability that a liability or asset will crystallize in the foreseeable future.

#### 2 Turnover

Turnover, all of which arises in the United Kingdom, represents amounts receivable, excluding value added tax, for goods and services invoiced during the year.
