#### REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

#### Realisation of assets:

After our appointment, the Company's inter group debt was taken under control until distribution.

Realisations from the Company's assets are as detailed in the above summary and totalled £4,559,436.

No additional assets have been identified and there are no assets still to be realised.

#### Settlement of liabilities:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency and the Company's records showed the Company had no liabilities.

The distribution in specie consisted of a book debt due from Oracle Corporation UK Limited. The value attributed to the in specie distribution was based on the value at which the asset was held in the Company's books.

#### **OUR FEES AND EXPENSES**

#### **Basis of remuneration:**

At the time of our appointment, a resolution was passed for us to be paid by reference to the time properly given by us and our staff in dealing with the liquidation.

#### Funding of the liquidation:

Although fees have been paid to us on the basis specified above, our fees and expenses have not been paid out of the liquidation estate. Instead, Oracle Corporation UK Limited have met our fees and expenses for the Company and one connected company.

#### Remuneration charged:

Our time costs for the period covering the formal liquidation of the Company and another group company amount to £29,139 in total.

The above time costs for the liquidation period are calculated to 25 September 2019, being the last practicable date. This represents 67.7 hours at an average hourly rate of £430.53.

£27,339 has been invoiced in total for this Company and another group company to 25 September 2019. It is our normal practice to obtain the prior approval of Oracle Corporation UK Limited before fees are invoiced and final fees will be agreed and invoiced in due course.
