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## BUSINESS AND SHARE TRANSFER AGREEMENT

between

**TUSSAUDS LIMITED (1)**

**TUSSAUDS ATTRACTIONS LIMITED (2)**

and

**TUSSAUDS HOLDINGS LIMITED (3)**

relating to the transfer of  
the city centre attractions business of  
Tussauds Limited

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THIS AGREEMENT is made the 14<sup>th</sup> day of APRIL 1999

BETWEEN:

- (1) TUSSAUDS LIMITED, a company incorporated in England and Wales (Registered No. 215035) and having its registered office at York Court, Allsop Place, Marylebone Road, London NW1 5LR, (the "Vendor");
- (2) TUSSAUDS ATTRACTIONS LIMITED (formerly Warwick Castle Limited), a company incorporated in England and Wales (Registered No. 1284934) and having its registered office at York court, Allsop Place, Marylebone Road, London NW1 5LR (the "Purchaser"); and
- (3) TUSSAUDS HOLDINGS LIMITED, a company incorporated in England and Wales (Registered No. 3622835) and having its registered office at York Court, Allsop Place, Marylebone Road, London NW1 5LR ("THL").



WHEREAS:

- (A) The Vendor carries on, inter alia, the business of operating city centre attractions.
- (B) The Vendor has agreed to sell and transfer and the Purchaser has agreed to purchase the Assets and the Transferring Businesses as going concerns on the terms and conditions set out in this Agreement.
- (C) THL, as the Vendor's parent company, has agreed to give certain warranties as set out in this Agreement.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

**1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

Words and expressions used in this agreement shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with Schedule 6. The Schedules to this Agreement shall be construed as part of this Agreement.

**2. SALE AND PURCHASE**

The Vendor shall sell and transfer the Transferring Businesses and the Assets and the Purchaser shall purchase them with effect from the date of this Agreement.

**3. CONSIDERATION**

The consideration for the purchase of the Transferring Businesses and the Assets shall be:

- 3.1 the Cash Consideration (which shall be left outstanding as a debt payable by the Purchaser to the Vendor on demand and shall accrue simple interest from day to day (the rate of 8% per annum));
- 3.2 the issue by the Purchaser of the Loan Stock;
- 3.3 the issue of 2,500,000 ordinary shares of £1.00 each by the Purchaser credited as fully paid (the "Consideration Shares"); and
- 3.4 the assumption by the Purchaser of the Liabilities,

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(together, the "Consideration").

The Consideration shall be allocated by the Vendor and the Purchaser between the respective Assets and the Liabilities and such allocation shall be recorded in a separate agreement to be entered into as soon as practicable after the date of this Agreement (but such allocation shall in no way affect the respective obligations of the parties under this Agreement).

**4. COMPLETION/TITLE**

- 4.1 The Acquisition shall be completed on the date of this Agreement when (to the extent they have not already done so) the Vendor and the Purchaser shall comply with their obligations as set out in Schedule 1.
- 4.2 The Purchaser acknowledges that certain of the Assets, including the Properties and the Equipment, are and will remain subject to the charges granted under debenture and guarantee in favour of Bankers Trust Company as Security Trustee to which the Vendor acceded on 6th November 1998.

**5. EFFECTIVE DATE**

The Vendor and the Purchaser intend that as between themselves, the Acquisition should have economic effect as if it had completed on the Effective Date. To this end:

- 5.1 the Cash Consideration and the terms of the Loan Stock are intended to include interest (or sums equivalent to interest) in respect of the period between the Effective Date and the Date of this Agreement;
- 5.2 the consideration allocated to those Assets whose constituent elements have changed since the Effective Date shall be the relevant value of those Assets as at the Effective Date;
- 5.3 the Vendor covenants that it has since the Effective Date conducted the Transferring Businesses in the ordinary course (save only to the extent required by preparations to complete the Acquisition on the terms set out in this Agreement); and
- 5.4 to the extent lawful, the Purchaser and the Vendor shall each account for the Acquisition as if it had completed on the Effective Date.

**6. WARRANTIES**

- 6.1 Each of the parties to this Agreement warrants, represents to and undertakes with the others that it has the necessary power, authority and capacity to enter into and perform this Agreement and to perform its obligations hereunder and that this Agreement constitutes a valid and binding obligation in accordance with its terms.
- 6.2 THL warrants to the Purchaser that the SPA Warranties (insofar as they relate to or may be applicable to the Assets or the Transferring Businesses) were true and accurate on 19th October 1998 (subject to any fact, matter, event or circumstance which is a "Disclosed Matter" as defined in the SPA).

6.3 THL liability under Clause 6.2 will be subject to the limitations (*mutatis mutandis*) set out in clauses 9.2(a) (time limit for claims) and 9.4 (aggregate cap) of the SPA.

7. EMPLOYEES

7.1 It is agreed that the contracts of employment of the Transferring Employees will transfer to the Purchaser with effect from the date of this Agreement in accordance with the Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 1981.

7.2 The Vendor indemnifies and undertakes to keep the Purchaser indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs, claims, demands and liabilities whatsoever (excluding any claims in respect of pensions) relating to or arising out of any claim that the employment relationship of any person (other than the Transferring Employees) has been transferred as a result of the Acquisition.

7.3 The Purchaser indemnifies and undertakes to keep the Vendor indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs, claims, demands and liabilities whatsoever relating to or arising out of any claim in respect of any of the Transferring Employees (other than claims to the extent the Vendor's insurers accept liability).

8. CONTRACTS

8.1 It is agreed that with effect from the date of this Agreement, the Purchaser shall assume the obligations, and become entitled to the benefits of the Vendor under the Contracts (and insofar as the Vendor can assign the same, it does so by this Agreement), and shall carry out and complete the Contracts (or shall procure that the Contracts are carried out and completed), to the extent that the same have not previously been carried out or completed, in a proper and workmanlike manner and in accordance with their respective terms. The Purchaser shall indemnify the Vendor and keep it fully indemnified against all liabilities, losses, actions, proceedings, costs, claims, demands and expenses brought or made against or incurred by the Vendor in respect of the non-performance or defective or negligent performance by the Purchaser (to the extent specified above) of the Contracts after the date of this Agreement.

8.2 If any Contract cannot be assigned by the Vendor to the Purchaser except with a consent to assignment or without the assignment constituting an event of default or termination (or otherwise giving the counterparty rights which it would not have had in the absence of such assignment), no assignment takes place by virtue of this Agreement until an appropriate consent or waiver has been obtained, but:

8.2.1 the Vendor and the Purchaser shall (at the request of the Purchaser) together take all reasonable steps to procure that the Contract be novated or to obtain a consent or waiver as soon as practicable after such request;

8.2.2 as from the date of this Agreement and unless or until such Contract shall have been novated or assigned or the provision waived, the Vendor shall hold the Contract in trust for the Purchaser and the Purchaser shall, at its own cost and for its own

benefit, perform the Vendor's obligations under such contract arising after the date of this Agreement and indemnify the Vendor against all liability (and all costs reasonably incurred by the Vendor) in connection therewith; and

- 8.2.3 if the other party to such Contract claims or alleges a breach on the grounds that the Vendor is no longer actually performing such Contract, the Purchaser shall offer in writing to such party to carry out the Contract on the same terms as may have been required of the Vendor.

## 9. LIABILITIES AND EXCLUDED LIABILITIES

- 9.1 Subject to Clause 7 (Employees) and Clause 8 (Contracts) the Purchaser hereby assumes with effect from the date of this Agreement and indemnifies the Vendor against the Liabilities.
- 9.2 For the avoidance of doubt, the Purchaser assumes no responsibility or liability for the Excluded Liabilities.

## 10. POST COMPLETION

- 10.1 After the date of this Agreement, the Vendor shall, forthwith upon receipt, forward to the Purchaser, any notices, correspondence, information or enquiries which relate to the Transferring Businesses.
- 10.2 To the extent that any moneys are received after Completion by one party which belong to the other party, the recipient shall (subject to any provisions to the contrary contained in this Agreement) hold the same on trust for that other party and account to that other party for them within five Business Days of receipt.
- 10.3 The Vendor shall use its best endeavours to procure that the deeds of assignment and licences to assign the Leasehold Properties to the Purchaser are duly executed within 60 days of the date of this Agreement.
- 10.4 As from the date of this Agreement and until such time as each of the Assets other than the Contracts is finally vested in the Purchaser, the Vendor shall hold and shall be deemed to have held it in trust for and for the benefit of the Purchaser.
- 10.5 It is acknowledged that the Purchaser may give notice of the assignment of any Debtor under this agreement to the relevant debtor.

## 11. AGENCY

- 11.1 Subject to Clause 11.2 the Vendor agrees with the Purchaser that it will, to the extent lawful and to the extent it is able to do so, act as agent for the Purchaser and occupy the Leasehold Properties pending the receipt by the Purchaser of such, assignment or licence as are required to enable the Purchaser to occupy the Leasehold Properties.
- 11.2 The Purchaser indemnifies and undertakes to keep the Vendor indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs, claims, demands and liabilities whatsoever relating to or arising out of any claims in respect of any action or omission of the Vendor pursuant to Clause 11.1.

11.3 Without prejudice to the provisions of Clause 11.2, the Vendor shall not be entitled to charge any management or similar fee for the performance of its obligations pursuant to Clause 11.1.

12. VALUE ADDED TAX

12.1 The Purchaser and the Vendor shall use all reasonable endeavours to procure that the transfer of the Transferring Businesses and the sale of the Assets is treated as a transfer of a business as a going concern for the purposes of the Section 49 of the VAT Act and Article 5 of the Value Added Tax (Special Provisions) Order 1995.

12.2 The Vendor shall forthwith deliver to the Purchaser all the records of the Transferring Business for VAT purposes which are required by Section 49 of the VAT Act to be preserved by the Purchaser.

12.3 The Purchaser shall for a period of not less than 6 years from the date of this Agreement preserve the records delivered to it by the Vendor pursuant to sub-Clause 12.2 and, upon reasonable notice during normal business hours, make them available to the Vendor or its agents.

12.4 If the Vendor discloses all material facts relating to the transfer of the Transferring Businesses and sale of the Assets under this Agreement to HM Customs & Excise and HM Customs & Excise confirm in writing that VAT is chargeable on the transfer under this Agreement or on any part of it then:-

12.4.1 the Vendor shall provide to the Purchaser a VAT invoice in respect of that VAT and the Purchaser agrees that subject to Clause 12.4.2 the VAT will be payable in addition to the consideration and the Purchaser shall be responsible for paying such amount;

12.4.2 Subject to Clause 12.4.3 below the Purchaser shall not be obliged to pay the Vendor VAT unless and until three business days after it receives credit or repayment of such VAT as input tax from HM Customs & Excise and the Purchaser agrees to use all reasonable endeavours to obtain such credit or repayment and if the Purchaser is not entitled to credit or repayment in respect of the entire amount of VAT which would otherwise be charged under this Clause the Purchaser and the Vendor shall negotiate in good faith to determine what sum the Purchaser should pay the Vendor in respect of VAT, it being agreed that the Purchaser shall in no circumstance be obliged to pay the Vendor more than an amount which (taking into account the amount of input tax the Purchaser is able to recover) leaves the Purchaser in no worse position than it would have been had Article 5 applied to the transfer of the Transferring Businesses and the sale of the Assets;

12.4.3 If the Vendor wishes to challenge any determination of HM Customs & Excise that VAT is chargeable on the transfer under this Agreement or on any part of it, the Purchaser shall provide such information as the Vendor may reasonably request in order to pursue such challenge. The Vendor shall provide security reasonably acceptable to the Purchaser for the anticipated costs and expense and shall indemnify the Purchaser in respect of any

reasonable costs and expenses which the Purchaser incurs in complying with its obligations under this Clause 12.4.3.

## 13. NOTICES

- 13.1 All notices, requests, demands or other communications in connection with this Agreement to or upon the respective parties shall be given by personal delivery or by being sent by recorded delivery mail posted within the United Kingdom:
  - 13.1.1 in the case of the Vendor to its registered office or to such other address in the United Kingdom as it may from time to time notify to the Purchaser for such purposes and in every event it and the envelope containing the same must be clearly marked "For the urgent attention of the managing director"; and
  - 13.1.2 in the case of the Purchaser to its registered office or to such other address in the United Kingdom as it may from time to time notify to the Vendor for such purposes and in every event it and the envelope containing the same must be clearly marked "For the urgent attention of the managing director".
- 13.2 Any such notice, request, demand or communication shall:
  - 13.2.1 if delivered personally be deemed to have been received at the time of such delivery or if delivery is not on a Business Day at 9.00am on the Business Day following such delivery; and
  - 13.2.2 if given by recorded delivery mail be deemed to have been received at 9.00am on the second Business Day occurring after the date of posting.

## 14. INSURANCE

From the date of this Agreement, the Purchaser shall be entitled to the benefit of the current insurances of the Vendor on or in connection with the Assets and the Transferring Businesses.

## 15. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement and the documents to be delivered in accordance with Schedule 1 contain the entire Agreement between the Vendor and the Purchaser with respect to the transaction contemplated herein and shall supersede all prior proposals, representations, agreements and negotiations relating thereto, whether written, oral or implied, between the parties hereto or their respective advisers or any of them (save in respect of fraudulent misrepresentations).

## 16. GENERAL

- 16.1 Notwithstanding Completion, this Agreement shall, except in so far as then implemented remain in full force and effect.
- 16.2 None of the benefits of and rights under this Agreement may be assigned or transferred in whole or in part.

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- 16.3 Except where a time limit is imposed under the terms of this agreement no failure or delay by the Purchaser to exercise any right or power hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof nor shall any partial exercise preclude any other or further exercise or the exercise of any other right.
- 16.4 The Vendor and the Purchaser shall after Completion each execute such documents and do such things as may be reasonably required to transfer to the Purchaser the Vendor's interest in the Transferring Businesses and the Assets. It is acknowledged that this Clause would (without limitation) apply to the entering into of individual assignments of any of the Debtors and assignments of the trade marks listed in Schedule 3 in a form appropriate for registration in each relevant jurisdiction.

**17. GOVERNING LAW**

This Agreement shall be governed and construed in all respects in accordance with the Law of England and the parties hereto irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the High Court in England.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF this Agreement has been entered into the day and year first above written.

## SCHEDULE 1

## COMPLETION

1. The Vendor shall deliver or cause to be delivered to the Purchaser at or as soon as practicable after the date of this Agreement:
  - (a) duly executed transfers into the name of the Purchaser of all the UK Shares, together with the relevant share certificates (if any) or an indemnity in respect of any missing share certificates;
  - (b) a duly executed notarial deed of transfer regarding the shares in Madame Tussauds Scenerama BV;
  - (c) a duly executed transfer in the name of the Purchaser of the shares in Madame Tussauds Australia Pty Limited;
  - (d) a copy of the resolutions of the board of directors (certified by a duly appointed officer as true and correct) of the Vendor, authorising the execution of and the performance by the Vendor of its obligations under this Agreement and each of the other documents to be executed by the Vendor pursuant to this Agreement;
  - (e) properly transfers, licences to assign and a conveyance in respect of the properties as set out in Schedule 4 of this Agreement in the agreed terms; and
  - (f) a duly executed assignment of the trade marks listed in Schedule 3 in favour of the Purchaser and duly executed assignments of domain names and copyright held by the Vendor in relation to the Transferring Businesses.
2. The Vendor shall on the date of this Agreement place the Purchaser in effective possession and control of the Transferring Businesses, and cause to be delivered to the Purchaser all of the Assets, which are capable of passing by delivery.
3. The Purchaser shall on the date of this Agreement:
  - (a) issue the Consideration Shares to the Vendor and deliver to the Vendor a certificate for such Consideration Shares;
  - (b) issue the Loan Stock to the Vendor and deliver to the Vendor a certificate for such Loan Stock; and
  - (c) deliver to the Vendor a copy of minutes (certified by a duly appointed officer as true and correct) of the Purchaser, authorising the execution of and performance by the Purchaser of its obligations under this Agreement and each of the other documents to be executed by the Purchaser pursuant to this Agreement.

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SCHEDULE 6

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 In this Agreement including the Schedules the following words and expressions shall unless the context otherwise requires have the following meanings:

"Acquisition"	means the acquisition by the Purchaser of the Transferring Businesses and the Assets;
"Assets"	means the Books and Records, Properties, Contracts, Equipment, Goodwill, Intellectual Property Rights, Stock, Debtors, and Shares;
"Books and Records"	means the accounting, employee payroll and other books and records of the Transferring Business or (where such records relate both to the Transferring Business and another business carried on by the Vendor) copies thereof;
"Business Day"	means a day on which banks in London are normally open for business (other than Saturdays and Sundays);
"Cash Consideration"	means £108,600,000 plus an amount equivalent to simple interest at 8% per annum accruing from day to day from (and including) the Effective Date to (but excluding the date of this Agreement) being in aggregate £109,028,449 ;
"Completion"	means the completion of the sale and purchase of the Transferring Businesses and the Assets;
"Contracts"	means the benefit (subject to the burden) of all:  (i) the contracts of the Vendor listed in Schedule 2; and  (ii) any other contracts of the Vendor to the extent they relate to the Transferring Businesses, which:

- arose in the ordinary course of the trading of the Transferring Business; or
- were otherwise reflected in the Books and Records;

"Debtors"

means:

- (i) the Vendor's right to collect and retain the proceeds of the debts listed in Annexure C (to the extent not collected or otherwise discharged by the date of this Agreement) together with any other trade debts owed to the Vendor and arising exclusively from the operation of the Transferring Business the date in respect of which Annexure C was prepared); and
- (ii) the benefit of intra-group receivables owed to the Vendor;

"Effective Date"

means the close of business on 27th March 1999;

"Equipment"

means Vendor's interest in:

- (i) the equipment and other movable assets listed in Annexure B; and
- (ii) any other equipment of the Vendor used exclusively in the Transferring Businesses;

"Excluded Assets"

means the car parking spaces demised by a lease dated 19th August 1996 made between Reedbase Limited (1) and The Tussauds Group Limited (2);

"Excluded Liabilities"

means:

- (i) any liabilities, obligations, actions, proceedings, debts, damages, liabilities, claims, costs, expenses and taxes of the Vendor howsoever arising, whether before or after the date of this Agreement, which arise (or to the extent they arise) out of the conduct of any business

- by the Vendor other than the Transferring Businesses (including the Vendor's Liability to Barclays Bank PLC, in relation to the £1.5 million loan facility); and
- (ii) any liability of the Vendor for corporation tax in respect of the Transferring Businesses;
- "Freehold Properties" means the Vendor's interest in the properties identified in Part A of Schedule 4;
- "Goodwill" means the goodwill of the Vendor in relation to the Transferring Businesses together with the exclusive right of the Purchaser to represent itself as carrying on the Transferring Businesses in succession to the Vendor;
- "Intellectual Property Rights" means the Vendor's interest in:
- (i) the registered trade marks and applications for registration of trade marks listed in Schedule 3; and
- (ii) any other intellectual property rights of the Vendor used exclusively in the Transferring Businesses;
- "Leasehold Properties" means the Vendor's interest in the properties identified in Part B of Schedule 4;
- "Liabilities" means:
- (i) all obligations, actions, proceedings, debts, damages, liabilities, claims, costs and expenses excluding taxes howsoever arising, whether before or after the date of this Agreement, which arise (or to the extent they arise) out of the conduct of the Transferring Businesses (but not including the Excluded Liabilities) and which:
- arose in the ordinary course of the trading of the

Transferring  
Business; or

were otherwise,  
reflected in the  
Books and Records;

- (ii) the Vendor's liability to THL of £13,646,000 (together with accrued and accruing interest) representing amounts lent by THL from borrowings under THL's revolving credit facility; and
- (iii) liabilities in respect of VAT, PAYE and National Insurance contributions to the extent relating to the Transferring Business and the Transferring Employees;

"Loan Stock"

means £6,270,000 15% unsecured subordinated loan stock 2025 of the Purchaser constituted on the terms set out in the Loan Stock Instrument (and which shall bear interest or amounts equivalent to interest from the Effective Date);

"Loan Stock Instrument"

means the instrument of the Purchaser in the agreed terms evidencing the constitution of £6,270,000 15% unsecured subordinated loan stock 2025;

"Properties"

means the Freehold Properties and the Leasehold Properties;

"Retained Business"

means any business carried on by the Vendor immediately prior to the date of this Agreement other than the Transferring Businesses;

"Shares"
