Notes to the financial statements

(forming part of the financial statements)

1 Accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the financial statements of UKMEX and Associates Limited (the "company").

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, including Financial Reporting Standard 102 – "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102"), and with the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements are presented in Sterling (£) which is the functional currency of the company.
