1 CORPORATE INFORMATION

The financial statements of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2016 were authorised for issue in accordance with a resolution of the directors on 24 July 2017. The Company is an unlisted limited company incorporated and domiciled in England and Wales. Its registered office is located at Prospect House, Rouen Road, Norwich NR1 1RE.
