The statement of assets and liabilities attached to the declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation (the "Declaration"), detailed an intercompany debt of £8,046,918 due from Molex Interconnect GmbH This debt will be distributed prior to the conclusion of the liquidation

The Company had no known creditors Notices to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation were advertised in The London Gazette, The Times, and the Gwent Gazette The liquidators also notified the solicitors of three former employees with potential industrial claims Each solicitor confirmed that their files had been closed

Two industrial injury claims are currently being investigated by the Company's insurers

Tax

All pre-liquidation corporation tax matters were handled by KPMG Tax who prepared and submitted all outstanding returns up to the date of the commencement of the liquidation to HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC") The joint liquidators are awaiting confirmation from HMRC that the Company has no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it will not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it has no objection to the liquidators calling a final meeting of members to conclude the liquidation

A similar assurance has been sought from HMRC in respect of VAT matters

Distributions

No distributions have been made

Joint liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 28 October 2010 that the remuneration of the joint liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company

In the event, the liquidators' remuneration will be paid by Woodhead Connectivity BV and accordingly no detailed analysis is included in this report
