We have examined the abbreviated financial statements on pages five to seven together with the full financial statements of Trolcharm Limited prepared under Section 226 of the Companies Act 1985 for the year ended 30th April 1995.

# Respective responsibilities of directors and auditors

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

# Financial Reporting Standard Number 1

Exemption has been taken from preparing a cash flow statement on the grounds that the company qualifies as a small company.

#### Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of services, excluding value added tax.

#### Tangible fixed assets

#### **Foreign Currencies**

Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction.
