The amount of the cost, loss or liability shall be equal to the amount which that Finance Party would otherwise have been entitled to recover.

### 1.2 Continuing guarantee

The guarantee is a continuing guarantee and will extend to the ultimate balance of sums payable by any Borrower or any other guarantor under the Finance Documents, regardless of any intermediate payment or discharge in whole or in part.
