1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents net amounts invoiced during the year (excluding value added tax) adjusted for accrued and deferred income where applicable.

Depreciation
