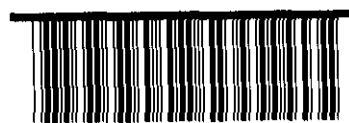

**Respective responsibilities of directors and auditors**





1. Accounting policies
